1. What is maturity? What is it based on? Is it easy or difficult to be mature? Does it in fact depend on one's age or not at all? Why?
2. How does life experience help in making a particular decision? Provide examples to explain the point.
3. What is the role of family for an adult person and for a child? How different or similar are these points of view?
4. What does a sense of balance or equilibrium in life mean to you? What are the necessary conditions to attain this state?
5. What plans or goals would you like to work towards in the near future? What factors do you need to consider to achieve what you wish? Justify your answer.
6. Which period of life can be regarded as the most important one: childhood, teenage years, early adulthood, middle age, old age? Justify your opinion by taking into consideration as many points of view as possible: society, a particular person, family, etc.
7. How does life experience contribute to maturity? Give examples to illustrate your answer.
8. Why do some people tend to read horoscopes regularly and believe what they find in them? Give several reasons.
9. Should we believe our intuition when we communicate with others? Is intuition always helpful when judging people's intentions? Justify your opinion.
10. Do you think that taking care of one's looks is a positive or a negative quality? Explain your answer.
11. Have you ever chosen a friend only on the basis of their good looks? Why/ why not?
12. Why do young people tend to pay more attention to looks than to personality?
13. In what ways can looks be helpful in everyday life? Give examples.
14. In what situations can looks be an impediment? Give examples.
15. Do you think that good looks can be a source of happiness? Give examples.
16. Why do you think many people treat their pet animals as best friends and companions for life?
17. In what ways can a pet be beneficial for its owner's health? Give examples.
18. In what ways and to what extent can pets bring harm to their owners and their households? Give examples.
19. What positive emotions can pet animals help develop in their owners?
20. Why do some people keep rare animals as pets? How can their choice of pets be explained?

21. Enumerate the features of an ideal pet animal. Then think of an animal that satisfies all your criteria. Justify all your criteria and your choice of the pet.
22. Does their life in the country actually contribute to people's health? Provide examples.
23. What sort of cultural events and entertainment are available and popular in the country? Give reasons for their popularity.
24. In what sense is country life more and in what sense is it less comfortable than living in the city?
25. "Country life ensures more privacy." Do you agree or disagree with this statement?
26. "Country life is only boring for people who live in the city." What is your opinion of this statement? Justify your view.
27. If you were given a choice between living in a big city and living in the country, where would you like to live? Why?
28. Which arrangement is more beneficial: renting on one's own or sharing a place? Why?
29. Provide some examples of factors and behaviour that landlord may not accept in a rented flat. Give reasons for your choice.
30. Enumerate the features of an ideal landlord or landlady. How can one reconcile one's needs with the needs of the house owner?
31. What can individuals sharing a flat do in order to ensure a peaceful, trouble-free coexistence? How should they organize their time and space?
32. Do you think making children attend school at a very early age is beneficial or harmful to them? Justify your opinion.
33. How old were you when you started your school education? From your point of view, what were the advantages/ drawbacks of going to school at that age?
34. Who should decide that a child is ready to receive preschool education- educational authorities, parents, or perhaps the child him/herself? Justify your opinion.
35. How can children be encouraged to learn? Give examples to illustrate your answer.
36. Which type of education can bring better results in your opinion, e-learning or traditional education? Justify your view.
37. In what way can modern technology assist people in their learning? Give examples.
38. "Teachers are not necessary for actual learning." To what extent do you agree or disagree with this statement?
39. Do you think that e-learning has a chance to become the only type of education in the future? Justify your opinion.
40. Do you find the stress connected with exams overwhelming or motivating? Justify your answer.
41. What are your ways of dealing with exam stress? Give examples.

42. Do you think there should be some compulsory subjects to take in “Matura”? What should they be? How many subjects should be the minimum? Justify your answer.
43. Is education a right or a privilege? Justify your answer.
44. Do you think it is more important to gain knowledge and learn facts at school or rather develop learning skills, such as critical reading, logical thinking, etc? What do you sacrifice if you choose one at the expense of the other?
45. Which institution affects children more: school or family? Justify your answer.
